### **HARRY HARDWICK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

The New England Sheep and Wool Growers Association annually presents TWO memorial awards for \$750.00 each. To qualify, a student must have completed one year of his or her undergraduate studies or be enrolled in graduate school. The applicant cannot be in a Dual Enrollment program (enrolled in High School and College at the same time).

**FIRST AWARD: Student must be majoring in an agriculture field**

**SECOND AWARD: Student should have a 4H, FFA, or Youth Sheep Project background, but may be majoring in a non-agricultural field**

These awards are available to residents of the New England States and Eastern New York State where the New England Sheep and Wool Growers Association have an appointed director, or to students who are members of NESWGA, or have family that are members of NESWGA.

The application and resume for the Harry Hardwick Memorial Award is attached and must be postmarked by the application deadline posted on the NESWGA website. Three Letters of recommendation must be enclosed with the application. The individual completing the recommendation may return it to you in a sealed envelope.
